

THURLOW NUNN LEAGUE

HOSPITALITY REQUIREMENTS

Premier Division, Division One (North) and Division One (South)

Visitors Room

A room or reserved area, whether separate or part of the Club's own clubhouse, shall be made available for League Officials and visiting Club Officials, pre-match, half time and at full time for partaking of refreshments. This room or reserved area must be a minimum of 120 square feet, be in good decorative order and have no other use on match days.

Refreshments

Complimentary teas must be provided for Players, Match Officials and visiting League and Club Officials, pre-match, at half time and again at full time. It is also expected sandwiches, biscuits, and other light refreshments will be served to visiting League and Club Officials at half-time and again at full time and to Match Officials and Players at full time.

Gate admission charges

All League and Cup games shall have a minimum full, adult admission charge of £5.00. Concessionary reductions are permitted. This entrance charge to the ground is the responsibility of the home Club. All spectators, other than League officials, Club officials of both teams and representatives of the League's sponsor who show a current League Pass, shall be charged accordingly.

Under 23 League(s)

Refreshments

Complimentary teas should be provided for Players, Match Officials and visiting League and Club Officials, pre-match, at half time and again at full time. It is also expected sandwiches, biscuits, and other light refreshments will be served to visiting League and Club Officials at half-time and again at full time and to Match Officials and Players at full time.

Gate admission charges

It is down to the home club to decide whether or not to charge for admission to games in the Under 23 League(s). League Passes are not issued to teams in the Under 23 competition.

Youth League

Refreshments

A complimentary drink of tea, coffee or squash, whichever is required, should be available on arrival for any player, club officer or match official should they request the same. (The onus here is on the participants.)

Without being asked for, unless otherwise refused by the participants, a drink should be available in both team changing rooms and the match officials' room at half time.

After the completion of the game, **if the home club so chooses**, light refreshments, e.g. sausage and chips or sandwiches, etc, may be served in the club house, not the changing rooms (unless specifically requested), to all players, club officers and match officials who remain at the ground. If the home club is not providing post-match hospitality, this should be communicated to the opponents and match officials prior to the day of the game.

Gate admission charges

It is down to the home club to decide whether or not to charge for admission to games in the Youth League. League Passes are not issued to teams in the Under 18 competition.
